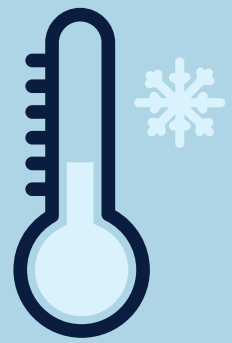




# LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)



## LIHEAP Cash and Crisis Grants Help Pay Heating Bills

Homeowners and renters paying for heat to a utility company or fuel vendor (oil, coal, wood, etc.) must provide a bill or receipt and meet income guidelines.

Renters paying for heat as part of the rent are also eligible with a landlord statement.

| Household Size | Monthly Income Limit | Annual Income Limit |
|----------------|----------------------|---------------------|
| 1              | \$1,595              | \$19,140            |
| 2              | \$2,155              | \$25,860            |
| 3              | \$2,715              | \$32,580            |
| 4              | \$3,275              | \$39,300            |
| +1             | \$560                | \$6,720             |
